Minutes

Brad talked about a meeting that he and Dr. Selke attended. They went to the Animal Care Center regarding the treatment of the steers at the fair. A 5-2 vote was passed not to bring up the issue again.

Dr. Selke went and spoke to the manager at the Pima county animal care advisory committee and was assured that no one associated with his facility will go to the fair and tell them how to manage the animals.

Old Business

Purchase of new panels for swine area- Dr. Selke said 153 pigs were tagged, percentage of animals that show up at the fair is about 79 and 89 percent. 140 pens purchased would be Dr. Selke's suggestion. 6 groups of 20 pens and 1 group of 14 pens. Total of 140 pens and 12 alley gates. 7 foot high on bow gate. Based on last year's figures we are looking at 35 to 36 thousand in cost. 8 thousand from Sales Committee, 6 thousand from 4-H, coordinator for swine needs to deal with the issue on pen assignments.

Patty Todd presented the duties page that we put together.

New Business
