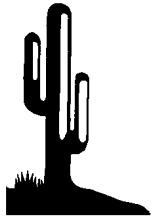




Pima County Junior Livestock Sales, Inc.
Large Stock Auction



What to do with the purchased animal:

Option 1:

If you wish to have the animal processed for your personal use, you will select a processor from the sale program. They will pick up the animal from the auction and then contact you when your meat products are ready.

Option 2:

If you wish to help a 4-H or FFA member but do not wish to keep the processed meat, check "Consignment to Packer" on the sales agreement and the Auction Committee will make arrangements for you. By indicating consignment to packer, you agree to pay the difference between the final selling price (the price you bid) and the current market prices for steers, lambs, goats, or hogs. (Current floor prices will be posted at the sale.)

Option 3:

You may wish to donate an animal to a charitable organization. Options include:

1. Donate animal to be processed for organization's use (you are responsible for the expenses and arrangements for the slaughter, cutting instructions, and delivery of the meat).
2. Have animal sold to packer with these proceeds sent to the organization of your choice.

Option 4:

With the exception of the Grand and Reserve animals, you may take the animal home yourself after the closure of the Fair (Sunday evening).
